## ONE Conducts the First Global Stowage Planning Office Summit in Kumamoto, Japan

**13<sup>th</sup> December 2018 – Singapore** - Ocean Network Express (“ONE”) conducted the first Global Stowage Planning Office (SPO) Summit during 10<sup>th</sup> and 11<sup>th</sup> December 2018 in Kumamoto, Japan. The summit aims to improve stowage planning skills for its internal staff in more safety condition.
