Suez Canal Incident: Status Update - 26 March 2021 AM

Dear Valued Customer,

We regret to report that the Suez Canal passage is currently blocked to vessels in both directions due to the vessel ran aground in the Suez Canal at around 8 am local time on March 23. This incident occurred as the container ship proceeded northbound through the waterway from the Red Sea.

At the time of this update, the incident continues block the waterway, stopping vessels from passing, resulting in schedule delays.

Refloating attempts are being carried out by the owners of the vessel in coordination with Suez Canal Authorities.
